

TERI Summer School Rules and Concert Etiquette

To help everyone enjoy Summer School, we kindly ask all participants to observe the following venue rules and concert etiquette.

To ensure that everyone understands these expectations, we ask all teachers who have students who will be attending to review these rules with both students and parents before they arrive. The rules will also be reviewed during registration, and participants will have an opportunity to ask any questions. A copy of these rules will also be provided to all participants.

Concert Etiquette

- **Photography, video recording, and audio recording are not permitted during any lessons or concerts.** Photos with teachers and friends before or after lessons and concerts are welcome.
- Please sit quietly during all concerts. Do not talk, walk around, or otherwise disturb the performance.
- Once a concert has begun, please remain seated until the end whenever possible. If you must enter or leave the hall during a concert, you may do so only between pieces. Teachers stationed at the doors will let you know when it is appropriate to enter or exit. Please follow their directions.

Food and Drink

- Please eat lunch only in the designated lunch areas. These are public facilities, so please do not eat in lobbies or other common areas unless they are specifically designated for lunch. Signs will indicate the designated lunch areas.
- You may eat lunch in the group lesson room before afternoon group lessons begin. Once lessons start, no food is permitted in the room.
- No food or drinks are permitted in TERI Hall or Kissei Hall.
- Food is not permitted in any room of the Agata no Mori Cultural Hall. However, participants may drink water as needed to prevent heat-related illness.

Care of the Facilities

- Summer School is being held in public facilities. Please help us keep them clean by cleaning up after yourself.
- If you purchase a boxed lunch through Summer School, the lunch containers will be collected after lunch. All other trash should be taken back to your hotel for disposal.
- Please do not use the electrical outlets at any venue. Charge your devices at your hotel before coming to Summer School.
- Do not enter rooms that are not being used for Summer School. All rooms being used for our event will be clearly marked with a Summer School sign.
- Please do not play your instrument outside or in the hallways. Instruments may only be played in the assigned classrooms.
