

[Important] To All Participants of the 75th Summer School [Please Read Carefully]

For Overseas Participants

The 75th Summer School is just around the corner.

We kindly ask that you **read the following information carefully before arriving in Matsumoto.**

Name Tags

All participants are required to wear their name tags during Summer School.

You will receive your name tag at the Participant Reception:

- **Violin, Cello, and Flute:** July 29
- **Piano:** July 31

If you have reserved a bus, a **bus icon** will be printed on your name tag:

- One icon for a single day reservation
- Two icons for a two-day reservation

If you purchased a ticket for the **Special Faculty Concert on August 2**, it will be included in your name tag holder.

If you ordered **boxed lunches**, your lunch ticket(s) will also be included.

When you receive your name tag, please check that everything that you requested when registering is included with your name tag.

 - **Location:** TERI Hall Entrance on the 3rd Floor

 - On July 29, **an information session for overseas participants** (V,C,F) will follow immediately after checking in at the reception. Please be on time.
 - **Piano Reception**
 - **Date/Time:** July 31 (Friday) 9:45~12:00
 - **Location:** TERI Lobby (3-10-3 Fukushima, Matsumoto-shi, Nagano-ken 390-0815)
 - At the reception, each group will check in using **the representative's name and the assigned group number**. The group number will be provided to the representative in advance, so please make sure to bring it to the reception desk.
 - At the reception, the group representative will receive a packet for the group. The packet will contain all the materials needed for the all of the members of the group (programs, name tag holders, etc.).
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What to Bring

- Your instrument (except for Piano students)
- Violin, Viola & Cello students should bring spare strings
- Items to help prevent heatstroke.
(A hat or umbrella for the sun is suggested. Also, it is highly recommended that you bring water. There are no water fountains at the venues, so please bring water with you.)
- Good walking shoes
- Sheet music, pencil, notebook (as needed)
- Students in classes 15-18 will need a music stand for ensemble.
- Indoor slippers or clean socks for anyone who will enter the rooms for Violin Classes No. 3, 4, 6, 8, 10A, 10B, and 15; Cello Classes No. 40, 41, and 45; all Flute classes; and the String Ensemble A Class. **Outdoor shoes are not permitted in these rooms.**

Buses & Transportation

- 18:00-18:20: Departure from Kissei Bunka Hall~ to Matsumoto Station (East Exit)

August 1 (Saturday)

- 08:30-08:50: Departure from Matsumoto Station (East Exit) ~to Kissei Bunka Hall
- 15:00-15:20: Departure from Kissei Bunka Hall~ to Matsumoto Station (East Exit)

The bus at the Matsumoto station will be in front of the building to the right after exiting the station from the East Exit.

For those arriving by car:

- Please use one of the paid parking lots around the Talent Education Research Institute.
- On July 31 and August 1, you may use the **free parking** at Kissei Bunka Hall.

- **Do not use the parking lots of Matsumoto Kinrosha Fukushi Center, Fukashi Shrine, or Agata-no-Mori Bunka Kaikan.**
 - Stopping for pick-up/drop-off near the venues is also prohibited as it causes traffic problems.

Additional Information

- Violin classes 10 and 12 will be divided into two groups. **Students from overseas will be in 10B and 12B.**
- The **Afternoon Concert** in the TERI Hall on July 30 (Thursday) will be live-streamed in Room 3-3 of Matsumoto Kinrosha Fukushi Center.
You may also watch the live stream on your personal device (smartphone, tablet, etc.). The viewing URL will be sent to all participants by email at a later date.
- The **Special Concert** and **Special Faculty Concert** on July 31 is **open to the public.**

All other programs are for registered participants only — even family members may not enter if they have not registered. Please be aware of this rule.

- On the evening of **August 1**, there will be a local festival (*Matsumoto Bonbon*) in the city, and traffic restrictions will be in place during certain hours. There will also be many people. If you're staying near the station, please take this into account.
- Do not enter any rooms that are not being used for Summer School. Do not practice outside the venues or in the hallways.
- **Infectious disease prevention measures** are the responsibility of each individual.
- **Please make sure that your name is on your instrument and all of your belongings. TERI will not be responsible for lost items.**
- **Please make sure to obtain travel insurance before coming to Japan. Medical expenses can be very high for visitors without coverage.**
